It was 18<sup>th</sup> of January 2003. The Jayantotsav celebrations of His Holiness Padmabhushan Jagadguru Dr. Sri Sri Sri Balagangadaranatha MahaSwamiji were in full swing. Just then, an announcement was made that changed the course of my life. I was transferred from Mangaluru to New Delhi to start a new branch of BGS schools. I vividly remember Maha Swamiji's profound words. He said, 'Punam, I am shouldering you with a big responsibility, to start our first school in northern India.' Rest, as they say, is history.

With the divine benediction of Param Poojya Maha Swamji, I landed in New Delhi on the 4<sup>th</sup> of March 2003. I was new to the city, and I didn't know which way the wind would blow. It was under the invaluable guidance of our Managing Director Sri Sri Dr. Prakashnath Swamiji, and the support of Mr. M.K. Ganjoo, Secretary BGSIPS, that I started my journey.
